## MESSAGE FROM PASTOR TAMARA

Hello all,

I hope everyone has had a great summer. It's so hard to believe that summer is coming to an end because it seems like summer just started. But here we are, ready to start fall and enjoy the crisp air and falling, colorful leaves. I look forward to an outdoor service on 9/15 with a potluck and blessing of the backpacks. I hope everyone can make it.

With fall comes the start of the school year and the start of our Christian education in the church. The Christian education team met on 8/18 to work through the planning and here's what we have planned for this year:

- JAM: every other Wednesday 3:30-4:30 pm; September meetings: 9/11 and 9/25; schedules will be available at first JAM meeting; open to middle school age and older youth
- Confirmation: opposite Wednesdays 3:30-5:00 pm; September meeting: 9/18/24; schedules will be sent to confirmation students; open to grades 5 and up
- Sunday School: during the service on Sundays; children to leave after passing the peace; starts 9/22/24

• Bible Study: 1st Sunday of the month after church at 10:15 am, beginning 10/6/24; will be various topics about our church and how the Bible guides us; first Sunday will be about how we are the UCC and how the Bible shaped us as a church; open to all

• Reading Club: replaces Book study; 3rd Sunday of the month after church at 10:15 am, beginning 10/20/24; topics will be current events, current movies, popular topics of the times; first topic will be the status of the Church in our current culture and how we are a part of it–pre-reading materials will be copied and placed in fellowship hall by 10/06/24; open to all

We have a busy schedule, as you can see above, and hope everyone is able to find something they would like to attend. However, we also need help from everyone. Our JAM and confirmation meetings need adult volunteers to be present and bring snacks. We are seeking volunteers to meet with us on Wednesdays 3:30-4:30 or -5:00 pm. Our safe church policy requires two adults who are not related to each other to be present whenever children or youth are meeting with someone for church activities. Lori will be leading JAM and Tamara will be leading confirmation; please let one of us know if you can help attend a session for JAM and/or confirmation.

Sunday School also needs another adult present so if you're willing to help with that, please let Missy know as she is taking the lead for Sunday School. Thank you in advance for volunteering to help ensure we have a strong faith formation program for our children!

And that's not all for our Christian education journey this year. I am committing to creating a short article each month that will help everyone begin to understand more about our United Church of Christ, its polity, its belief system, and more. So please stay tuned for this in each newsletter, starting in October.

I pray that we all find growth opportunities as we head into fall and then winter. Enjoy the shorter days and crisper weather and spend time with loved ones.
